With ICEP support, Hullabaloo 22 will deliver:

- A summer-long programme of activity between March August 2022
- The festival will draw together and amplify a mixture of **existing and new** activity, events, outputs and projects from providers across ipswich, **online and in-person**
- The 'Tell Your Story' theme will provide a unifying framework for activity while allowing space for a wide variety of art forms and approaches to flourish
- New targeted projects will directly address barriers to participation for young people
- All activity will be amplified by the Hullaballoo badge and online presence including a dedicated website to share your profile/activity and free marketing materials
- **Joint programming opportunities and events** will support collaborations between education settings, arts and community organisations, artists and young people.
